Bead angles were measured. This shows at what angle the paint panel has to be at for water to start running off. An untreated control panel had to be at 15° before water started to run off.









### **DURABILITY TESTS**

Durability tests were carried out on a black high solids clear coat and a black 2-pack polyurethane paint panels. Products were applied as instructed then washed with diluted car shampoo. The test was ended when the products stopped beading water and started sheeting water instead.



This shows High Definition Wax's phenomenal durability – at least 6 times better than the nearest competitor.

### **TECHNICAL EXPLANATION**


Autoglym's High Definition Wax is a special formulation, containing a blend of selected solvents for a controlled, even application and evaporation rates. It's a complex blend of hard, tough and durable polymers, resins, high melt natural and synthetic waxes. Including Carnauba wax, microcrystalline wax, solid saturated hydrocarbons, resin wax and highly branched polymerised hydrocarbons and oils (PDMS). It imparts a brilliant, high gloss, long-lasting, weather and abrasion resistant finish or barrier to paintwork against most environmental contaminants (e.g. salt, water, detergents, UV rays, acid rain, industrial fallout and dirt). It does not contain harsh abrasives and is free of water and emulsifiers which could interfere with the performance.



### CAR WASH & DETAIL CENTERS

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High Definition Wax is a perfect blend of waxes and solvents that has been carefully created by the Autoglym R&D team to achieve the ultimate finish. Understandably, they are not prepared to divulge all of their ingredients or methodology. However, the Autoglym laboratory has confirmed that High Definition Wax does feature the following waxes:



- · Natural Carnauba wax · High melt synthetic polymeric wax
- · Saturated hydrocarbon wax · Hard microcrystalline wax

The levels of these ingredients are a closely guarded secret, but the percentage that matters most is that High Definition Wax does contain 100% Autoglym expertise.
